

Marine Biological Corridor

Part of the Eastern Tropical Pacific (ETP) Swimway, which connects marine protected areas from Costa Rica to the Galapagos and supports migration and genetic diversity, the Gulf of Chiriquí Marine Biological Corridor is one of Panama's most biodiverse regions. From lush rainforests and mangroves to the deep, nutrient-rich waters of the Pacific, it serves as a vital reproductive and nursing ground for countless species.

At the heart of this corridor, within a protected area, the Islas Secas archipelago offers the perfect base for a marine safari.



Big Blue Five

Twenty miles from mainland and an hour from UNESCO World Heritage Coiba National Park, Islas Secas is the perfect spot to look for incredible marine megafauna, season dependent

Hammerheads March to late August

Manta Rays June to October

Connected is *Protected*

Islas Secas is a protected archipelago of 14 islands, featuring secluded coves and mangrove stands. It plays a vital role in the Gulf of Chiriquí Marine Biological Corridor, serving as a key stopover for species like snappers, sea bass, and sharks, which travel between the shallow coastal mangroves and the open Gulf waters. The archipelago also supports diverse birdlife that relies on its forests and islands for nesting and feeding.
